Section 2. Paragraph (k) is added to subsection (1) of section 1003.02, Florida Statutes, to read:

1003.02 District school board operation and control of public K-12 education within the school district.—As provided in part II of chapter 1001, district school boards are constitutionally and statutorily charged with the operation and



11 control of public K-12 education within their school districts.
12 The district school boards must establish, organize, and operate
13 their public K-12 schools and educational programs, employees,
14 and facilities. Their responsibilities include staff
15 development, public K-12 school student education including
16 education for exceptional students and students in juvenile
17 justice programs, special programs, adult education programs,
18 and career education programs. Additionally, district school
19 boards must:

20 (1) Provide for the proper accounting for all students of
21 school age, for the attendance and control of students at
22 school, and for proper attention to health, safety, and other
23 matters relating to the welfare of students in the following
24 areas:

25 (k) Instructions on emergency first aid for choking.-
26 Require that a poster that contains step-by-step instructions on
27 how to provide emergency first aid for choking on conscious
28 individuals be posted in each public school cafeteria within the
29 school district. The poster must be easily visible and
30 prominently placed.
