6 Section 2. Section 288.067, Florida Statutes, is created  
7 to read:

8 288.067 Emergency Rental Assistance Program.-

9 (1) The Emergency Rental Assistance Program is created,  
10 subject to appropriation, within the department to provide  
11 financial assistance to state residents who reside in rented  
12 residential property and for whom the circumstances of such  
13 housing have been adversely affected by Hurricane Ian or  
14 Hurricane Nicole.

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15       (2) The department shall adopt rules to implement this  
16 section, including rules providing eligibility standards for  
17 program fund recipients.

18       Section 3. The Department of Economic Opportunity may, and  
19 all conditions are deemed to be met to, adopt emergency rules  
20 pursuant to s. 120.54(4), Florida Statutes, to administer ss.  
21 288.066 and 288.067, Florida Statutes, as created by this act.  
22 Notwithstanding any other law, emergency rules adopted pursuant  
23 to this section are effective for 6 months after adoption and  
24 may be renewed during the pendency of procedures to adopt  
25 permanent rules addressing the subject of the emergency rules.

26       Section 4. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, the sum of \$100  
27 million in nonrecurring funds is appropriated from the General  
28 Revenue Fund to the Department of Economic Opportunity to fund  
29 the Emergency Rental Assistance Program established by this act
