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1002.395 Florida Tax Credit Scholarship Program.—

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(6) OBLIGATIONS OF ELIGIBLE NONPROFIT SCHOLARSHIP-FUNDING ORGANIZATIONS.—An eligible nonprofit scholarship-funding organization:

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(p) Must prepare and submit quarterly reports to the

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Department of Education pursuant to paragraph (9)(i). In

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addition, an eligible nonprofit scholarship-funding organization must submit in a timely manner any information requested by the Department of Education relating to the scholarship program.

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- Information and documentation provided to the Department of Education and the Auditor General relating to the identity of a taxpayer that provides an eligible contribution under this section shall remain confidential at all times in accordance with s. 213.053.
- (9) DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OBLIGATIONS.—The Department of Education shall:
- (i) Require <u>monthly quarterly</u> reports by an eligible nonprofit scholarship-funding organization regarding <u>all of the following:</u>
- 1. The number of applications received by the organization, sorted by county.
- 2. The number of scholarships awarded by the organization, sorted by county.
- 3. The number of scholarships funded and the number of students participating in the scholarship program, sorted by county.
- 4. The percentage of students who applied for a scholarship, were awarded a scholarship, and who are participating in a scholarship program:
