Senate Joint Resolution

A joint resolution proposing the creation of Section 33 of Article X of the State Constitution to prohibit the state or its political subdivisions from placing and operating traffic infraction detectors for specified purposes.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the following creation of Section 33 of Article X of the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose:

ARTICLE X

MISCELLANEOUS

SECTION 33. Prohibition on traffic infraction detectors.-

The state or a political subdivision thereof is prohibited from placing and operating traffic infraction detectors used for the purpose of detecting when a driver of a motor vehicle fails to stop at a traffic signal. This prohibition does not apply to the placement and operation of traffic infraction detectors on portions of roadways established as school speed zones.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:
