6 Remove lines 25-50 and insert:

7 1. "Current wholesale price" means the wholesale price for
8 each fresh food product on the invoice date at the closest
9 shipping point as reported by the United States Department of
10 Agriculture's Market News.

11 2. "Food producer" means an agricultural company, or their
12 associated shipper, that produces fresh food products in the
13 state.

14 3. "Food recovery entity" means a nonprofit association
15 engaged in food recovery and distribution that has at least 10
16 years of operation in the state and has received a minimum of 10

17 million pounds of perishable fresh food products annually for
18 the last 3 years.

19 4. "Fresh food products" means high-quality fresh fruits,
20 vegetables, proteins, and dairy produced by a food producer that
21 are delivered to their final destination for charitable
22 distribution and meet United States Department of Agriculture
23 commodity standards and grades upon such delivery.

24 (b) Subject to legislative appropriation, the department
25 shall implement a pilot program for food recovery entities to
26 negotiate a discounted price for fresh food products so that the
27 fresh food products can be exclusively distributed for
28 charitable purposes to relieve human hunger in the state.

29 (c) Food recovery entities must negotiate and pay no more
30 than 50 percent of the current wholesale price to a food
31 producer for the purchase of fresh food products. The harvest or
