- 4. "Fresh food products" means high-quality fresh fruits, vegetables, proteins, and dairy produced by a food producer that are delivered to their final destination for charitable distribution and meet United States Department of Agriculture commodity standards and grades upon such delivery.
- (b) Subject to legislative appropriation, the department shall implement a pilot program for food recovery entities to negotiate a discounted price for fresh food products so that the fresh food products can be exclusively distributed for charitable purposes to relieve human hunger in the state.
- (c) Food recovery entities must negotiate and pay no more than 50 percent of the current wholesale price to a food producer for the purchase of fresh food products. The harvest or processing date and the current wholesale price of each

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
