



26        1. The total number of rules currently in effect under the  
27 jurisdiction of the agency.

28        2. The number of rules promulgated by the agency in the  
29 past year.

30        3. The number of rules withdrawn by the agency in the past  
31 year.

32        4. A regulatory review exercise in which the agency  
33 proposes reductions in rule counts equal to 10 percent, 20  
34 percent, and 30 percent of the total rules currently in effect  
35 for the agency.

36        (b) The committee shall advise and assist agencies in  
37 preparing base and revised inventories of rules and in achieving  
38 specified percentage reductions in rules in the Florida  
39 Administrative Code, including exercises of reductions of rules  
40 inventories by 10 percent, 20 percent, and 30 percent.

41        (c) By December 1 of each year, the staff director of the  
42 committee shall prepare a historical report aggregating the  
43 reports received from agencies for the preceding year. In the  
44 report, the staff director shall describe the work of the  
45 committee over the preceding year with respect to reduction of  
46 rules and shall indicate, out of the total number of rules  
47 inventoried by agencies, the percentage by which agencies have  
48 reduced those rules. The report shall include recommended  
49 statutory changes as appropriate to address any statutory  
50 provisions that are brought to the committee's attention as

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51 contributing to the adoption of regulatory restrictions. The  
52 staff director shall provide the report to the committee,  
53 publish the report on the committee's website, and transmit  
54 copies of the report electronically to the President of the  
55 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

56 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
