18	(b) The department shall establish a <del>matching</del> grant
19	program to provide funding to regional economic development
20	organizations for the purpose of building the professional
21	capacity of those organizations. Building the professional
22	capacity of a regional economic development organization
23	includes hiring professional staff to develop, deliver, and
24	provide needed economic development professional services,
25	including technical assistance, education and leadership
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development, marketing, and project recruitment. Matching Grants may also be used by a regional economic development organization to provide technical assistance to local governments, local economic development organizations, and existing and prospective businesses.

(c) A regional economic development organization may apply 31 32 annually to the department for a matching grant. The department 33 is authorized to approve, on an annual basis, grants to such 34 regional economic development organizations. The maximum amount an organization may receive in any year will be \$50,000, or 35 \$250,000 for any three regional economic development 36 organizations that serve an entire region of a rural area of 37 38 opportunity designated pursuant to s. 288.0656(7) if they are 39 recognized by the department as serving such a region.

40 (d) Grant funds received by a regional economic 41 development organization must be matched each year by nonstate 42 resources in an amount equal to 25 percent of the state 43 contribution.

44 (2) In approving the participants, the department shall
45 consider the demonstrated need of the applicant for assistance
46 and require the following:

47 (a) Documentation of official commitments of support from
48 each of the units of local government represented by the
49 regional organization.

(b) Demonstration that each unit of local government has

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51 made a financial or in-kind commitment to the regional 52 organization. 53 (c) Demonstration that the private sector has made 54 financial or in-kind commitments to the regional organization. 55 (b) (d) Demonstration that the organization is in existence 56 and actively involved in economic development activities serving 57 the region. 58 (c) (c) Demonstration of the manner in which the 59 organization is or will coordinate its efforts with those of 60 other local and state organizations. 61 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.

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
