33 Section 2. Section 166.0496, Florida Statutes, is created  
 34 to read:

35 166.0496 Automated external defibrillator required for  
 36 municipality owned or operated parks and youth recreation or  
 37 sports facilities.—

38 (1) Each municipality owned or operated park and youth  
 39 recreation or sports facility must have on the premises at all  
 40 times a functioning automated external defibrillator.

41 (2) A municipality that provides an automated external  
 42 defibrillator shall ensure that employees and volunteers are  
 43 properly trained in accordance with s. 401.2915.

44 (3) The location of each automated external defibrillator  
 45 shall be registered with a local emergency medical services  
 46 medical director.

47 (4) The use of automated external defibrillators by  
 48 volunteers shall be covered under the provisions of ss. 768.13  
 49 and 768.1325.

50 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
