A bill to be entitled

An act relating to county budget officers; amending s. 129.025, F.S.; specifying that the county budget officer reports directly to the board of county commissioners; prohibiting such officer from being a member of the executive branch of county government unless otherwise authorized; specifying the powers of certain county entities while acting as ex-officio budget officers; providing that any actions by such officers do not violate specified prohibitions; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 129.025, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

129.025 County budget officer.-

- (1) (a) Each board of county commissioners may designate a county budget officer to carry out the duties set forth in this chapter. The county budget officer reports directly to the board and may not be a member of any executive branch of county government, except as authorized in paragraph (b).
- (b) Unless the board designates a different officer, the clerk of the circuit court or the county comptroller, if applicable, shall be the ex-officio budget officer for the purposes of this chapter. The clerk of the circuit court or the county comptroller, while acting as the ex-officio budget officer, reports to the board in a strictly legislative capacity, and any action taken by the clerk of the circuit court
