Section 1. Section 847.01385, Florida Statutes, is created
to read:

847.01385 Harmful Communication to a Minor.—

(1) As used in this section, the term:

(a) "Communication" means any verbal or written
communication.

(b) "Sexual activity" has the same meaning as in s.
