Section 1. Section 1004.444, Florida Statutes, is amended
to read:

1004.444 Florida Center for Cybersecurity.-

(1) The Florida Center for Cybersecurity, which may also be referred to as "Cyber Florida," is established within the University of South Florida, under the direction of the president of the university or the president's designee.

- 13 (a) Position Florida as the national leader in
- 14 cybersecurity and its related workforce primarily through

- 16 initiatives in cybersecurity and related fields, with a
