Between lines 1228 and 1229, insert:

Section 12. Subsection (7) of section 403.0673, Florida
Statutes, is amended, and subsection (8) is created to read:
403.0673 Water quality improvement grant program.—A grant
program is established within the Department of Environmental
Protection to address wastewater, stormwater, and agricultural
sources of nutrient loading to surface water or groundwater.

(7) Beginning January 15, 2024, and each January 15
thereafter, the department shall submit a report regarding the
projects funded pursuant to this section to the Governor, the

16 President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of
17 Representatives.

18 (a) The report must include a list of those projects
19 receiving funding and the following information for each
20 project:

21 (i) ~~(a)~~ A description of the project;

22 (ii) ~~(b)~~ The cost of the project;

23 (iii) ~~(c)~~ The estimated nutrient load reduction of the
24 project;

25 (iv) ~~(d)~~ The location of the project;

26 (v) ~~(e)~~ The waterbody or waterbodies where the project
27 will reduce nutrients; and

28 (vi) ~~(f)~~ The total cost share being provided for the
29 project.

30 (b) The report must also include a status report on each
31 project funded since 2021. The status report must, at a minimum,
32 identify which projects have been completed and, if such
33 information is available, provide nutrient-load improvements or
34 water quality testing data for the waterbody.

35 (8) By July 1, 2025, the department must include the
36 projects funded pursuant to this section on a user-friendly
37 website or dashboard. The website or dashboard must allow the
38 user to see the information provided in subsection (7) and must
39 be updated at least annually.
