(8) (a) Each county recorder or clerk of the court must make the identity of each respondent against whom a final judgment for an injunction for the protection of a minor under s. 741.30, s. 784.046, or s. 784.0485 is entered, as well as the fact that a final judgment for an injunction for the protection of a minor under s. 741.30, s. 784.046, or s. 784.0485 has been entered against that respondent, publicly available on the county

21 providing a stand-alone link to the official records index. The
22 link must be located in a clear and conspicuous location on the
23 homepage of the county recorder's or clerk of the court's
24 official website and must be available for search by the general
25 public. The link must be titled in a manner that clearly informs
26 the user that by clicking the link, the user will be redirected
27 to a searchable database on which information available pursuant
28 to this subsection relating to the identity of a respondent
29 against whom a final judgment for injunction for the protection
30 of a minor can be found.

31 (c) ~~(b)~~ Any information specified in this subsection not
32 made available by the county ~~recorder~~ or clerk of the court as
33 provided in this subsection ~~on a publicly available Internet~~
