The identity and information required under this subsection shall be viewable 15 16 through a searchable database that is available in a clear and 17 conspicuous location on the homepage of the clerk's official website and shall be available for search by the general public. 18

19 (b) Any information specified in this subsection not made 20 available by the <del>county recorder or</del> clerk of the court as 21 provided in this subsection on a publicly available Internet 22 website for general public display before July 1, 2024, shall 23 2021, must be made publicly available on the clerk of the 24 court's official an Internet website if the affected party 25 identifies the information and requests that such information be 26 added to a publicly available Internet website for general 27 public display. Such request shall must be in writing and delivered by mail, facsimile, or electronic transmission or in 28 29 person to the <del>county</del> <del>recorder or</del> clerk of the court. The request 30 shall must specify the case number assigned to the final 31 judgment for an injunction for the protection of a minor under 32 s. 741.30, s. 784.046, or s. 784.0485.
