5 Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section  
6 322.051, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (11) is  
7 added to that section, to read:

8 322.051 Identification cards.—

9 (1) Any person who is 5 years of age or older, or any  
10 person who has a disability, regardless of age, who applies for  
11 a disabled parking permit under s. 320.0848, may be issued an  
12 identification card by the department upon completion of an  
13 application and payment of an application fee.

14 (a) The application must include the following information  
15 regarding the applicant:

16 1. Full name (first, middle or maiden, and last), sex  
17 ~~gender~~, proof of social security card number satisfactory to the  
18 department, which may include a military identification card,  
19 county of residence, mailing address, proof of residential  
20 address satisfactory to the department, country of birth, and a  
21 brief description.

22 2. Proof of birth date satisfactory to the department.

23 3. Proof of identity satisfactory to the department. Such  
24 proof must include one of the following documents issued to the  
25 applicant:

26 a. A driver license record or identification card record  
27 from another jurisdiction that required the applicant to submit  
28 a document for identification which is substantially similar to  
29 a document required under sub-subparagraph b., sub-subparagraph  
30 c., sub-subparagraph d., sub-subparagraph e., sub-subparagraph  
31 f., sub-subparagraph g., or sub-subparagraph h.;

32 b. A certified copy of a United States birth certificate;

33 c. A valid, unexpired United States passport;

34 d. A naturalization certificate issued by the United  
35 States Department of Homeland Security;

36 e. A valid, unexpired alien registration receipt card

38 f. A Consular Report of Birth Abroad provided by the  
39 United States Department of State;

40 g. An unexpired employment authorization card issued by  
41 the United States Department of Homeland Security; or

42 h. Proof of nonimmigrant classification provided by the  
43 United States Department of Homeland Security, for an original  
44 identification card. In order to prove nonimmigrant  
45 classification, an applicant must provide at least one of the  
46 following documents. In addition, the department may require  
47 applicants to produce United States Department of Homeland  
48 Security documents for the sole purpose of establishing the  
49 maintenance of, or efforts to maintain, continuous lawful  
50 presence:

51 (I) A notice of hearing from an immigration court  
52 scheduling a hearing on any proceeding.

53 (II) A notice from the Board of Immigration Appeals  
54 acknowledging pendency of an appeal.

55 (III) A notice of the approval of an application for  
56 adjustment of status issued by the United States Citizenship and  
57 Immigration Services.

58 (IV) An official documentation confirming the filing of a  
59 petition for asylum or refugee status or any other relief issued  
60 by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services.

61 (V) A notice of action transferring any pending matter  
62 from another jurisdiction to Florida, issued by the United  
63 States Citizenship and Immigration Services.

64 (VI) An order of an immigration judge or immigration  
65 officer granting relief that authorizes the alien to live and  
66 work in the United States, including, but not limited to,  
67 asylum.

68 (VII) Evidence that an application is pending for  
69 adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted for  
70 permanent residence in the United States or conditional  
71 permanent resident status in the United States, if a visa number  
72 is available having a current priority date for processing by  
73 the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services.

74 (VIII) On or after January 1, 2010, an unexpired foreign  
75 passport with an unexpired United States Visa affixed,  
76 accompanied by an approved I-94, documenting the most recent  
77 admittance into the United States.

79 An identification card issued based on documents required in  
80 sub-subparagraph g. or sub-subparagraph h. is valid for a period  
81 not to exceed the expiration date of the document presented or 1  
82 year, whichever occurs first.

83 (11) This section does not prohibit the department from  
84 issuing an identification card that fulfills the federal

87 Section 3. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section  
88 322.08, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

89 322.08 Application for license; requirements for license  
90 and identification card forms.—

91 (2) Each such application shall include the following  
92 information regarding the applicant:

93 (a) Full name (first, middle or maiden, and last), sex  
94 ~~gender~~, proof of social security card number satisfactory to the  
95 department, which may include a military identification card,  
96 county of residence, mailing address, proof of residential  
97 address satisfactory to the department, country of birth, and a  
98 brief description.

99 Section 4. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section  
100 322.14, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (3) is  
101 added to that section, to read:

102 322.14 Licenses issued to drivers.—

103 (1)(a) The department shall, upon successful completion of  
104 all required examinations and payment of the required fee, issue  
105 to every qualified applicant a printed driver license that must  
106 bear a color photograph or digital image of the licensee; the  
107 name of the state; a distinguishing number assigned to the  
108 licensee, which, beginning November 1, 2023, must have a minimum  
109 of four randomly generated digits on each original, renewal, or

110 replacement driver license; and the licensee's full name, date  
 111 of birth, and residence address; a brief description of the  
 112 licensee, including, but not limited to, the licensee's sex  
 113 ~~gender~~ and height; and the dates of issuance and expiration of  
 114 the license. A space shall be provided upon which the licensee  
 115 shall affix his or her usual signature. A license is invalid  
 116 until it has been signed by the licensee except that the  
 117 signature of the licensee is not required if it appears thereon  
 118 in facsimile or if the licensee is not present within the state  
 119 at the time of issuance.

120 (3) This section does not prohibit the department from  
 121 issuing a driver license that fulfills the federal identity  
 122 document requirements established by the REAL ID Act of 2005.
