18	conservation lands.
19	(5) BLUE ECONOMYBeginning with the assessment due on
20	January 1, 2025, and biennially thereafter, the Office of
21	Economic and Demographic Research shall include in the
22	assessment an evaluation of the state's blue economy. The
23	evaluation must include the following:
24	(a) Historical and current contributions of maritime
25	industries to the state's economy, including, but not limited
26	to:
27	1. Shipyards, marinas, marine terminals, piers, fishing,
28	aquaculture, seafood processing, commercial diving, and marine
