22 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public
23 necessity that any names, dates of birth, driver license
24 numbers, home addresses, mailing addresses, telephone numbers,
25 or electronic mail addresses in an application submitted to the
26 Department of Legal Affairs by a person seeking compensation
27 through the Dozier School for Boys and Okeechobee School Victim
28 Compensation Program be made confidential and exempt from s.
29 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the
30 State Constitution. The Legislature finds that the release of
31 such personal identifying information could subject the persons
32 applying for compensation through the Dozier School for Boys and
33 Okeechobee School Victim Compensation Program to the possibility
34 of harassment and to further trauma should their status as a
35 victim of the Dozier School for Boys or the Okeechobee School,
36 or the nature of the abuse each victim suffered there, be made
