Section 3. Subsection (2) of section 515.31, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:

515.31 Drowning prevention education program; public
information publication.—

(2) The department shall also produce, for distribution to
the public at no charge, a publication that provides information

12 ownership. The department, in lieu of developing its own
13 publication, may adopt a nationally recognized drowning

15 as provided in rule of the department. The department must

17 appropriate communication, information relevant to newborn and
18 infant drowning prevention and must make this information
19 available to health care facilities, including, but not limited
