Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 730-908 and insert:

7 Section 12. (1) The Department of Transportation shall
 8 convene a working group for the purpose of streamlining the
 9 process of developing, executing, and revising utility
 10 relocation agreements authorized under ss. 337.401 and 337.403,
 11 Florida Statutes, to facilitate timely relocation of utilities
 12 that are in conflict with the department's construction
 13 projects.

14 (2) The working group shall consist of the following
 15 members:

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16 (a) Eight members designated by department, one of whom is
17 a representative of the department's central office and seven of
18 whom each represent one of the department's districts.

19 (b) One member designated by each investor-owned electric
20 utility in this state.

21 (c) One member designated by the Florida Municipal
22 Electric Association who is a representative of municipal
23 electric and gas utilities.

24 (d) One member designated by the Florida Electric
25 Cooperatives Association, Inc., who is a representative of the
26 electric cooperative industry.

27 (e) Two members designated by the telecommunications
28 industry, one of whom is a wireless provider.

29 (f) One member designated by Florida Internet & Television
30 Association, Inc., who is a representative of the cable and
31 television industry.

32 (g) One member designated by the department who provides
33 broadband services.

34 (h) One member designated by the Florida Natural Gas
35 Association who provides natural gas distribution.

36 (i) Four members designated by the Florida Transportation
37 Builders' Association, Inc., who are representatives of the road
38 and bridge contractor industry.

39 (3) By January 2, 2025, the Department of Transportation
40 shall provide a report to the Governor, the President of the

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41 Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives which
42 contains a list of recommendations mutually agreed upon by the
43 department and the working group, including, but not limited to,
44 recommendations regarding any changes to current law or
45 administrative rules, in furtherance of the purpose provided in
46 subsection (1).
