Section 1. Subsection (7) is added to section 487.081, Florida Statutes, to read:

487.081 Exemptions.-

- (7) (a) A products liability action, including a failure to warn, may not be brought or maintained against an applicator of pesticides unless:
 - 1. The applicator exercised substantial control over an



12 aspect of the design, testing, manufacture, or labeling of the 13 product alleged to have caused the harm for which recovery of 14 damages is sought; 15 2. The applicator altered or modified the product, and the 16 alteration or modification was a legal cause of the alleged harm 17 for which recovery of damages is sought; 3. The applicator handled, used, or applied the product in 18

- a manner inconsistent with the product label, and such action or failure to warn was a legal cause of the alleged harm for which recovery of damages is sought;
- 4. The applicator engaged in some other negligent act relating to the pesticide, and such negligence was a legal cause of the alleged harm for which the recovery of damages is sought; or
- 5. The manufacturer of a product alleged to have caused the harm for which recovery of damages is sought is not subject to personal jurisdiction in this state.
- (b) This subsection applies only to pesticides as defined in s. 487.021.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
