448.110 State minimum wage; annual wage adjustment; enforcement.-
(3) Employers shall pay employees a minimum wage at an hourly rate of $\$ 6.15$ for all hours worked in florida. Only those individuals entitled to receive the federal minimum wage under the federal Fair Labor Standards Act, as amended, and its 252721

implementing regulations shall be eligible to receive the state minimum wage pursuant to s. 24 , Art. X of the State Constitution and this section. The provisions of ss. 213 and 214 of the federal Fair Labor Standards Act, as interpreted by applicable federal regulations and implemented by the Secretary of Labor, are incorporated herein.
(12) Beginning on July 1, 2024, employers shall pay employees a minimum wage at an hourly rate of $\$ 15$, or the highest wage negotiated in a contract resulting from a living wage ordinance, for all hours worked. This subsection does not apply to a small business as defined in s. 288.703. A small business shall adjust its minimum wage in accordance with the timeline established in s. 24(c), Art. X of the State Constitution.
