Senate Amendment (with title amendment)
Delete lines 18 - 66
and insert:
(1) Beginning November 3, 2026, and except as provided in
s. 124.011, relating to single-member districts after decennial
redistricting, a person may not appear on the ballot for
reelection to the office of county commissioner if, by the end
of his or her current term of office, the person will have
served, or but for resignation would have served, in that office
for 8 consecutive years. A person who has served in the office
