14	Section 1. Micromobility vehicles and related personal				
15	5 safety equipment; sales tax holiday				
16	(1) The tax levied under chapter 212, Florida Statutes,				
17	may not be collected during the period from July 1, 2024,				
18	through June 30, 2025, on the retail sale of micromobility				
19	vehicles and related personal safety equipment.				
20	(2) As used in this section, the term:				
21	(a) "Micromobility vehicle" means a human- or electric-				
22	powered transportation device, including a bicycle, a scooter,				
23	an electric-assist bicycle, an electric scooter, or other small,				
24	lightweight, wheeled conveyance, that weighs less than 500				
25	pounds, is less than 3 feet in width, and is designed for a				

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26 maximum speed of less than 30 miles per hour. (b) "Related personal safety equipment" includes helmets, 27 28 knee pads, elbow pads, and other personal safety equipment used 29 for the operation of a micromobility vehicle. 30 (3) The Department of Revenue is authorized, and all conditions are deemed met, to adopt emergency rules pursuant to 31 s. 120.54(4), Florida Statutes, for the purpose of implementing 32 33 this section. 34 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
