Remove lines 8-14 of the amendment and insert:

2023, if the minor applies for and receives a work waiver from the Department of Business and Professional Regulation authorizing the minor to work such hours. The work waiver must be signed by the minor; the minor's parent or legal guardian; and, if the minor is enrolled in school, the superintendent or school-based administrator, or his or her designee, of the school at which the minor attends. By August 1, 2024, each school must create a process for approving or denying a work waiver and such process must take into consideration the minor's
