Between lines 86 and 87, insert:

Section 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a minor may only be employed, permitted, or suffered to work more than the hours permitted under s. 450.081, Florida Statutes 2023, if the minor applies for and receives a waiver, which must be signed by the minor's parent or legal guardian, through the Department of Business and Professional Regulation authorizing the minor to work such hours. The superintendent or school-based administrator of the school at which the minor attends must also approve such waiver after taking into consideration the minor's
