27 28 A bill to be entitled

An act relating to graduate program admissions; creating s. 1004.032, F.S.; defining terms; requiring an institution of higher education to waive certain examination requirements for a servicemember who applies for admission to a graduate program that requires such examination; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 1004.032, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

- 1004.032 Graduate program admission for servicemembers.—
- (1) As used in this section, the term:
- (a) "GMAT" means the Graduate Management Admission Test.
- (b) "Graduate program" means an advanced academic degree program in a specialized field of study, including, but not limited to, a master's or doctoral degree program, which degree is pursued after one has obtained a bachelor's degree.
 - (c) "GRE" means the Graduate Record Examination.
- (d) "Institution of higher education" means a state university as defined in s. 1000.21(8).
 - (e) "Servicemember" has the same meaning as in s. 250.01.
- (2) An institution of higher education shall waive the GRE or GMAT requirement for a servicemember who applies for admission to a graduate program that requires such examination.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
