Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert: Section 1. Section 455.2123, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

9 455.2123 Continuing education.-A board, or the department 10 when there is no board, shall allow may provide by rule that 11 distance learning may be used to satisfy continuing education requirements. 27 <u>(a) (1)</u> Prorate continuing education for new licensees by 28 requiring half of the required continuing education for any 29 applicant who becomes licensed with more than half the renewal 30 period remaining and no continuing education for any applicant 31 who becomes licensed with half or less than half of the renewal 32 period remaining; or

33 <u>(b) (2)</u> Require no continuing education until the first 34 full renewal cycle of the licensee.

These options shall also apply when continuing education is first required or the number of hours required is increased by law or the board, or the department when there is no board.
