7 Section 1. Section 285.195, Florida Statutes, is created  
 8 to read:

9 285.195 State recognition of Indian tribes and bands.—This  
 10 state recognizes the Santa Rosa Band of the Lower Muscogee.  
 11 State recognition of an Indian tribe or band under this section  
 12 may not be construed to create any basis or authority not  
 13 otherwise provided by law for an Indian tribe or band to  
 14 establish or promote any form of otherwise prohibited gaming  
 15 activity. State cultural recognition of an Indian tribe or band  
 16 under this section does not provide those recognized with any

17 authority or ability to consult on issues related to state  
18 undertakings including those outlined in s. 267.031 or carried  
19 out under rule 1A-46, F.A.C., and does not provide any authority  
20 or ability to consult on activities carried out by the State  
21 Archaeologist as specified in s. 872.05.
