26 (c) All winning outcomes are determined predominantly by 27 accumulated statistical results of the performance of more than 28 one individual. 29 (d) A winning outcome may not be based on: 30 1. The score, point spread, or performance of a team or combination of teams. 31 2. The single performance of an individual in a single 32 event or a pari-mutuel event, as the term "pari-mutuel" is 33 34 defined in s. 550.002, Florida Statutes, as of January 1, 2021. 35 3. A game of poker or other card game. 36 4. The performance of participants in collegiate, high 37 school, or youth sporting events. (e) Casino graphics, themes, or titles, including, but not 38 39 limited to, depictions of slot machine-style symbols, cards, 40 dice, craps, roulette, or lotto, may not be displayed or 41 depicted. 42 (3) A violation of this section is punishable by a fine of 43 \$1,000. The Attorney General or state attorney may institute 44 proceedings to enjoin any person found to be violating this 45 section. (4) Any person who willfully and knowingly violates any 46 47 provision of this section commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. 48 49 Section 2.
