House Concurrent Resolution A concurrent resolution applying to the Congress of the United States to call a convention for the sole purpose of proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States which requires a balanced federal budget. WHEREAS, on April 21, 2010, the Legislature of the State of

9 Florida passed Senate Concurrent Resolution 10, which Resolution 10 made application to Congress to call a convention pursuant to 11 Article V of the Constitution of the United States to propose 12 amendments to the Constitution of the United States to achieve 13 and maintain a balanced federal budget and to control the 14 ability of Congress and federal executive agencies to dictate to 15 states requirements for the expenditure of federal funds, and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2014, the Legislature of the State of Florida passed Senate Memorial 658, which Memorial 658 made application to Congress to call a convention pursuant to Article V of the Constitution of the United States for the sole purpose of proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to require a balanced federal budget, and

22 WHEREAS, on May 2, 2023, the Legislature of the State of 23 Florida passed Senate Memorial 176, finding that in order to 24 ensure the stability of government and business functions at the 25 local, regional, state, and national levels, it is imperative

26 that the Federal Government take action to cut costs, reduce the 27 tax burden on American families and businesses, operate 28 according to principles of fiscal responsibility and discipline, 29 and balance the federal budget, and urging Congress to take 30 immediate action to begin to reduce the national debt and enact legislation requiring a balanced federal budget, and 31 32 WHEREAS, Congress continues to fail to introduce and enact 33 legislation requiring its members to pass a balanced budget, and 34 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Florida intends to 35 conform its application to the active single subject 36 applications made to Congress by the States of Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Colorado, Iowa, Idaho, Indiana, Kansas, Louisiana, 37 38 Michigan, Missouri, Mississippi, North Carolina, North Dakota, 39 Nebraska, New Hampshire, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Wisconsin, West Virginia, and 40 41 Wyoming, NOW, THEREFORE, 42 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of 43 44 Florida, the Senate Concurring: 45 46 (1)That the Legislature of the State of Florida applies to Congress, under Article V of the Constitution of the United 47 48 States, to call a convention limited to proposing an amendment 49 to the Constitution requiring that, in the absence of a national

51 Congress for any fiscal year may not exceed the total of all 52 estimated federal revenues for that fiscal year, together with 53 any related and appropriate fiscal restraints.

54 (2)That this application is to be considered as covering 55 the same subject matter as the presently outstanding balanced 56 budget applications from other states and is to be aggregated 57 with the applications from those states for the purpose of attaining the two-thirds number of states necessary to require 58 59 the calling of a convention, but may not be aggregated with applications on any other subject calling for a constitutional 60 convention under Article V of the United States Constitution. 61

(3) That this application constitutes a continuing
application in accordance with Article V until the legislatures
of at least two-thirds of the states have made applications on
the same subject.

66 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this concurrent resolution is revoked and withdrawn, nullified, and superseded to the same 67 68 effect as if it had never been passed, and retroactive to the 69 date of passage, if it is used for the purpose of calling a 70 convention or used in support of conducting a convention to amend the Constitution of the United States with any agenda 71 72 other than to propose an amendment to the Constitution requiring 73 that, in the absence of a national emergency, the total of all federal appropriations made by the Congress for any fiscal year 74 may not exceed the total of all estimated federal revenues for 75

76 that fiscal year, together with any related and appropriate 77 fiscal restraints.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this application be dispatched to the President of the United States, to the President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, to each member of the Florida delegation to the United States Congress, and to the presiding officer of each house of the legislature of each state.
