 2           An act relating to a review under the Open Government  
 3           Sunset Review Act; amending s. 24.1051, F.S.;;  
 4           providing for future legislative review and repeal of  
 5           an exemption from public record requirements relating  
 6           to the security of certain technologies, processes,  
 7           and practices; removing the scheduled repeal of  
 8           exemptions relating to information about lottery  
 9           games, personal identifying information of retailers  
 10          and vendors for purposes of background checks, and  
 11          certain financial information held by the Department  
 12          of the Lottery; providing an effective date.

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 14   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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 16           Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 24.1051, Florida  
 17           Statutes, is amended to read:

18           24.1051 Exemptions from inspection or copying of public  
 19           records.—

20           (1)(a) The following information held by the department is  
 21           confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I  
 22           of the State Constitution:

23           1. Information that, if released, could harm the security  
 24           or integrity of the department, including:

25           a. Information relating to the security of the

26 department's technologies, processes, and practices designed to  
27 protect networks, computers, data processing software, data, and  
28 data systems from attack, damage, or unauthorized access. This  
29 sub-subparagraph is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review  
30 Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed on  
31 October 2, 2027, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through  
32 reenactment by the Legislature.

33 b. Security information or information that would reveal  
34 security measures of the department, whether physical or  
35 virtual.

36 c. Information about lottery games, promotions, tickets,  
37 and ticket stock, including information concerning the  
38 description, design, production, printing, packaging, shipping,  
39 delivery, storage, and validation of such games, promotions,  
40 tickets, and stock.

41 d. Information concerning terminals, machines, and devices  
42 that issue tickets.

43 2. Information that must be maintained as confidential in  
44 order for the department to participate in a multistate lottery  
45 association or game.

46 3. Personal identifying information obtained by the  
47 department when processing background investigations of current  
48 or potential retailers or vendors.

49 4. Financial information about an entity which is not  
50 publicly available and is provided to the department in

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51 connection with its review of the financial responsibility of  
52 the entity pursuant to s. 24.111 or s. 24.112, provided that the  
53 entity marks such information as confidential. However,  
54 financial information related to any contract or agreement, or  
55 an addendum thereto, with the department, including the amount  
56 of money paid, any payment structure or plan, expenditures,  
57 incentives, bonuses, fees, and penalties, shall be public  
58 record.

59 (b) This exemption is remedial in nature, and it is the  
60 intent of the Legislature that this exemption apply to  
61 information held by the department before, on, or after May 14,  
62 2019.

63 (c) Information made confidential and exempt under this  
64 subsection may be released to other governmental entities as  
65 needed in connection with the performance of their duties. The  
66 receiving governmental entity shall maintain the confidential  
67 and exempt status of such information.

68 ~~(d) This subsection is subject to the Open Government~~  
69 ~~Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand~~  
70 ~~repealed on October 2, 2024, unless reviewed and saved from~~

72 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
