19 position that is designated in writing for access by the Chief
20 Justice of the Supreme Court or a chief judge of a district or
21 circuit court, or by his or her designee; or

22 3. A government employee who performs functions on behalf
23 of the state courts system in a position that is designated in
24 writing for access by the Chief Justice or a chief judge, or by
25 his or her designee; ~~or~~

26 (n) To the Agency for Health Care Administration pursuant
27 to an interagency agreement to prevent health care fraud. If the
28 Agency for Health Care Administration enters into an agreement
29 with a private entity to carry out duties relating to health
30 care fraud prevention, such contracts shall include, but need
31 not be limited to:

32 1. Provisions requiring internal controls and audit
33 processes to identify access, use, and unauthorized access of
34 information.

35 2. A requirement to report unauthorized access or use to
36 the Agency for Health Care Administration within 1 business day
37 after the discovery of the unauthorized access or use.
