5 WHEREAS, the University of Florida is the nation's top 6 public university, ranking first among all public institutions 7 by the Wall Street Journal based on value, graduation rates, and 8 the learning environment, and

9 WHEREAS, the University of Florida conducted a record \$1.25 10 billion in research over the previous fiscal year, funding new 11 healthcare discoveries, scientific exploration, agricultural 12 studies, and technological advancements, and

WHEREAS, UF Health Shands has nine medical specialties ranked in the top 50 nationwide, including five adult and four children's specialties, with dedicated doctors, researchers, and healthcare workers caring for patients from across the state and nation, and

18 WHEREAS, the UF College of Veterinary Medicine has launched 19 the first open-heart surgery program in the nation qualified to 20 treat dogs requiring a mitral valve repair, and

21 WHEREAS, the University of Florida continues to play a 22 significant role in the funding and accessibility of Artificial 23 Intelligence (AI), offering all students the Fundamentals of AI 24 course, access to an AI pathways career coach, and supporting K-25 12 AI education programs to accredit students and faculty with

27 WHEREAS, the Institute of Food and Agriculture Sciences 28 (UF/IFAS) conducted a record-breaking \$300 million in research 29 expenditures in fiscal year 2023, representing an 8 percent 30 increase from the previous year and a historical amount towards 31 Florida's agricultural and natural resources research and 32 advancement, and

33 WHEREAS, the UF Office of the President, under the 34 leadership of President Ben Sasse, announced in fall 2023 35 numerous strategic funding projects totaling over \$29 million 36 for 36 innovative research projects designed to advance the 37 student experience and interdisciplinary scholarship university 38 wide, with additional projects in the planning stages, and

39 WHEREAS, the Herbert Wertheim UF Scripps Institute for 40 Biomedical Innovation and Technology has yielded more than \$3.2 41 billion in economic impact within its first 20 years of 42 operation and continues to make advancements that benefit human 43 health and improve technology, and

WHEREAS, the UF Health Cancer Center was recently designated as a National Cancer Institute Designated Cancer Center due to its distinctive training programs, community outreach, and cutting-edge research and was awarded additional funding to further enhance care and attract world-class clinicians and researchers, and

59 WHEREAS, UF Health Shands Children's Hospital recently 60 earned a prestigious designation as a Level 1 pediatric trauma 61 center for fulfilling the American College of Surgeons' 62 standards of staff, resources, and equipment that enhance the 63 hospital's ability to handle children facing complex, life-64 threatening emergencies, joining numerous other UF Health Shands 65 specialties in their rankings, and

66 WHEREAS, the University of Florida is a participating 67 Yellow Ribbon school that provides supportive academic and 68 financial resources for veteran students through the Office of 69 Student Veteran Success and the UF Collegiate Veterans Success 70 Center, and is dedicated to giving back to those who have 71 served, and

WHEREAS, UF Health recently concluded the improvement and expansion of facilities within the Proton Therapy Institute to increase the number of rooms and personal treatment options for cancer patients, completing the seven-year, \$44 million
