15	WHEREAS, acknowledging, remembering, and learning from the
16	past, including the most painful parts, can help to prevent such
17	injustices from being repeated, and
18	WHEREAS, the remembrance of the Ocoee Massacre serves not
19	only as a tribute to the victims but also as a solemn reminder
20	of the ongoing journey towards racial equality and justice in
21	our state and nation, NOW, THEREFORE,
