25	Recycle Florida Today Foundation, Inc., to increase public

32	(128) BOATING CAPITAL OF THE WORLD LICENSE PLATES
33	(a) The department shall develop a Boating Capital of the
34	World license plate as provided in this section and s.
35	320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by
36	the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
37	plate, and the words "Boating Capital of the World" must appear
38	at the bottom of the plate.
39	(b) The department shall retain all annual use fees from
40	the sale of the plate until all startup costs for developing and
