29 | (128) BOATING CAPITAL OF THE WORLD LICENSE PLATES.—

30 | (a) The department shall develop a Boating Capital of the  
 31 | World license plate as provided in this section and s.  
 32 | 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by  
 33 | the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the  
 34 | plate, and the words "Boating Capital of the World" must appear  
 35 | at the bottom of the plate.

36 | (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall  
 37 | be distributed to Captain Sandy's Charities, a nonprofit  
 38 | organization under s. 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to  
 39 | be used to increase public awareness of maritime employment  
 40 | opportunities; to fund maritime workforce instruction and  
 41 | training; to promote professional development and job placement  
 42 | in all sectors of maritime employment; and to support the  
 43 | advancement of education of trainees in the maritime industry,  
 44 | both at sea and on land.

45 | Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
