16	registration database that would allow a person who has been
17	disqualified from voting based on a felony conviction to verify
18	his or her voter registration status and determine whether he or
19	she has any remaining obligations that must be satisfied before
20	his or her voting rights are restored. OPPAGA shall submit the
21	results of the study to the Governor, the President of the
22	Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives no later
23	than December 1, 2024.
24	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
