15 (b) The State Fire Marshal shall adopt rules to implement a uniform summary inspection report and submission procedures to 16 17 be used by all third-party vendors and local authorities having 18 jurisdiction. For purposes of this section, a uniform summary 19 inspection report must record the address at which where the 20 fire protection system or hydrant is located, the company and 21 person conducting the inspection and their license number, the date of the inspection, and the fire protection system or 22 23 hydrant inspection status, including the total number of 24 deficiencies found, separated into critical and noncritical 25 categories, and the brief description of impairment deficiencies 26 a brief summary of each deficiency, critical deficiency, 27 noncritical deficiency, or impairment found.
