**Amendment to Amendment (457515) by Representative Kincart  
Jonsson (with title amendment)**

Remove lines 9-25 of the amendment and insert:

**Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 393.0662, Florida  
Statutes, is amended to read:**

393.0662 Individual budgets for delivery of home and  
community-based services; iBudget system established.—The  
Legislature finds that improved financial management of the  
existing home and community-based Medicaid waiver program is  
necessary to avoid deficits that impede the provision of  
services to individuals who are on the waiting list for  
enrollment in the program. The Legislature further finds that

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17 clients and their families should have greater flexibility to  
18 choose the services that best allow them to live in their  
19 community within the limits of an established budget. Therefore,  
20 the Legislature intends that the agency, in consultation with  
21 the Agency for Health Care Administration, shall manage the  
22 service delivery system using individual budgets as the basis  
23 for allocating the funds appropriated for the home and  
24 community-based services Medicaid waiver program among eligible  
25 enrolled clients. The service delivery system that uses  
26 individual budgets shall be called the iBudget system.

27 (5) The agency shall ensure that clients and caregivers  
28 have access to training and education that inform them about the  
29 iBudget system and enhance their ability for self-direction.  
30 Such training and education must be offered in a variety of  
31 formats and, at a minimum, must address the policies and  
32 processes of the iBudget system and the roles and  
33 responsibilities of consumers, caregivers, waiver support  
34 coordinators, providers, and the agency, and must provide  
35 information to help the client make decisions regarding the  
36 iBudget system and examples of support and resources available  
37 in the community. The agency shall, within 5 days of enrollment,  
38 provide a client a comprehensive and current written list of all  
39 qualified organizations located within the region in which the  
40 client resides.
