6 Remove lines 101-111 and insert:

7 (3) HEALTH INFORMATION TRANSPARENCY.—In order to  
8 disseminate and facilitate the availability of comparable and  
9 uniform health information, the agency shall perform the  
10 following functions:

11 (n)1. Collect the overall assessment score of National  
12 Pediatric Readiness Assessments conducted by hospital emergency  
13 departments pursuant to s. 395.1012(5), from the Florida  
14 Emergency Medical Services for Children State Partnership  
15 Program by December 31, 2026, and by each December 31 during a

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16 year in which the National Pediatric Readiness Assessment is  
17 conducted thereafter.

18 2. By April 1, 2027, and each April 1 following a year in  
19 which the National Pediatric Readiness Assessment is conducted  
20 thereafter, publish the overall assessment score for each  
21 hospital emergency department, and provide a comparison to the  
22 national average score when it becomes available.

23 3. Collect and publish no more than one overall assessment  
24 score per hospital, per year, of assessments conducted pursuant  
25 to s. 395.1012(6), and provide a comparison to the hospital  
26 emergency department's most recently published score pursuant to  
27 subparagraph 2. of this paragraph.

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
