5 Remove lines 91-126 and insert:

6 330.411 Prohibited possession, alteration, or operation of  
7 unmanned aircraft or unmanned aircraft system.-

8 (1) As used in this section, the term:

9 (a) "Unmanned aircraft" has the same meaning as the term  
10 "drone" in s. 934.50(2).

11 (b) "Unmanned aircraft system" has the same meaning as in  
12 s. 330.41(2).

13 (2) A person may not knowingly or willfully possess or  
14 operate an unmanned aircraft or unmanned aircraft system as  
15 defined in s. 330.41 with an attached weapon, firearm,  
16 explosive, destructive device, or ammunition as those terms are

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17 defined in s. 790.001.

18 (3) (a) For the purposes of violating s. 330.41(4) (a), a  
19 person may not knowingly or willfully:

20 1. Alter, manipulate, tamper with, or otherwise change an  
21 unmanned aircraft or unmanned aircraft system's hardware or  
22 software to purposefully frustrate any tool, system, or  
23 technology intended to satisfy the remote identification  
24 requirements established by the Federal Aviation Administration  
25 as they relate to any unmanned aircraft or unmanned aircraft  
26 system; or

27 2. Possess or operate an unmanned aircraft or unmanned  
28 aircraft system that has been altered, manipulated, tampered  
29 with, or otherwise changed to purposefully frustrate any tool,  
30 system, or technology intended to satisfy the remote  
31 identification requirements established by the Federal Aviation  
32 Administration as they relate to any unmanned aircraft or  
33 unmanned aircraft system.

34 (b) This subsection does not apply if a person is  
35 authorized by the administrator of the Federal Aviation  
36 Administration or the Secretary of Defense, or their respective  
37 designees, to alter, possess, or operate such an altered  
38 unmanned aircraft or unmanned aircraft system.

39 (4) A person who violates subsection (2) or subsection (3)  
40 commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in  
41 s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

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42        (5) A person who, without lawful authority, possesses or  
43 operates an unmanned aircraft or unmanned aircraft system  
44 carrying a weapon of mass destruction or a hoax weapon of mass  
45 destruction, as those terms are defined in s. 790.166(1),  
46 commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in  
47 s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
