7 (5) (a) Members shall serve staggered terms of 5 years.

8 (b) A vacancy occurring during the term of a member shall
9 be filled in the same manner as the original appointment and for
10 the remainder of the unexpired term.

11 (c) A vacancy for a regional member may not be filled by
12 an individual who resides in the same region as a sitting
13 regional member.

14 (6) (a) The commission is authorized to take all necessary
15 actions to define the geographic boundaries of the five regions.

16 (b) The Governor shall ensure compliance with this section

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17 when appointing members to the commission.

18 ~~(7)(3)~~ Commission members shall receive no compensation
19 for their services as such, but shall be reimbursed for travel
20 expenses as provided in s. 112.061.

21 **Section 3. Subsection (1) and paragraph (a) of subsection**
22 **(2) of section 379.3311, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:**

23 379.3311 Police powers of commission and its agents.—

24 (1) The commission, the executive director and the
25 executive director's assistants designated by her or him, and
26 each commission officer are constituted peace officers with the
27 power to make arrests for violations of the laws of this state
28 when committed in the presence of the officer or when committed
29 on lands under the supervision and management of the commission,
30 the department, the Board of Trustees of the Internal
31 Improvement Trust Fund, or the Department of Agriculture and
32 Consumer Services, including state parks, coastal and aquatic
33 managed areas, and greenways and trails. The general laws
34 applicable to arrests by peace officers of this state shall also
35 be applicable to such director, assistants, and commission
36 officers. Such persons may enter upon any land or waters of the
37 state in the same manner and subject to the same requirements as
38 a law enforcement officer as defined in s. 943.10 for
39 performance of their lawful duties and may take with them any
40 necessary equipment, and such entry does not constitute a
41 trespass.

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42 (2) Such officers may enforce throughout the state all
43 laws relating to game, nongame birds, fish, and fur-bearing
44 animals and all rules and regulations of the commission relating
45 to wild animal life, marine life, and freshwater aquatic life,
46 and in connection with such laws, rules, and regulations, in the
47 enforcement thereof and in the performance of their duties
48 thereunder, to:

49 (a) Go upon all premises, in the same manner and subject
50 to the same requirements as a law enforcement officer as defined
