51 and such motor vehicle does not exceed 95,000 pounds. 52 Notwithstanding s. 320.01(7) or (12), truck cranes that tow 53 another motor vehicle under the provision of this subsection 54 shall be taxed under the provisions of s. 320.08(5)(b). 55 The Department of Transportation may issue a mobile (b) 56 crane special blanket permit to authorize a mobile crane and 57 accessory support vehicle of up to 12 feet wide, 14 feet 6 58 inches high, and 100 feet long to travel on and off the 59 Interstate Highway System at all hours except as restricted 60 under local travel-related curfews. The Department of Transportation may issue a mobile 61 (C) 62 crane special blanket permit to authorize a mobile crane and accessory support vehicle which, due to its design for use, 63 64 exceeds the weight limits established in s. 316.535 to travel on 65 and off the Interstate Highway System. Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025. 66
