(8) INTEGRATED DELIVERY SCHEDULE.—The Legislature recognizes the value of the integrated delivery schedule as a forward-looking snapshot of upcoming planning, design, and construction schedules for the comprehensive plan, as a tool that provides information to decision-makers and facilitates achievement of the goals and purposes of the comprehensive plan at the earliest possible time to the extent practical given funding, engineering, and other contractual constraints. The Legislature further recognizes that the schedule acts as a planning document and does not represent a budget or financial commitment on behalf of any of the participants of the South
