Each district school board shall 34 ensure that each school within the district has provided 35 training to school personnel on preventing and responding to an 36 allergic reaction, including anaphylaxis, and that each before-37 school and after-school program at a school within the district has provided such training to its employees and contracted 38 39 personnel. At least one member of the school personnel with such 40 training must be on school grounds to execute a student's 41 emergency action plan.
