Amendment to Amendment (476344) (with title amendment)

Between lines 71 and 72 of the amendment, insert:

Section 4. Subsection (4) is added to section 20.32, Florida Statutes, to read:

20.32 Florida Commission on Offender Review.—

(4) (a) For the purpose of assisting a volunteer who has been disqualified from voting based on a felony conviction other than murder or a felony sexual offense in determining whether he or she has met the requirements under s. 98.0751 to register as a petition circulator, the Department of State shall develop and

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13 maintain a database that contains for each such person all of
14 the following information:

15 1. His or her name and any other personal identifying
16 information.

17 2. The remaining length of any term of supervision,
18 including, but not limited to, probation, community control, or
19 parole, ordered by a court as a part of his or her sentence.

20 3. The remaining amount of any restitution owed to a
21 victim as ordered by a court as a part of his or her sentence.

22 4. The remaining amount due of any fines or fees that were
23 initially ordered by a court as a part of his or her sentence or
24 as a condition of any form of supervision, including, but not
25 limited to, probation, community control, or parole.

26 5. The completion status of any other term ordered by a
27 court as a part of his or her sentence.

28 6. Any other information needed to determine whether he or
29 she has met the requirements to register to circulate petitions
30 for a constitutional amendment ballot initiative.

31 (b) Each month, the Department of Corrections, clerks of
32 the circuit courts, county comptrollers, and the Board of
33 Executive Clemency shall provide to the Division of Elections
34 any information held by such governmental entity which is
35 required under paragraph (a).

36 (c) The Department of Management Services, acting through
37 the Florida Digital Service, shall provide any technical

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assistance necessary for the Department of State to develop and maintain the database. The Department of Management Services may adopt rules to provide such assistance.

(d) By July 1, 2028, the Florida Commission on Offender Review shall make available to the public the database on an Internet website. The commission must update the database monthly with the information received under paragraph (b). The commission shall publish on the website clear instructions that a person who has been disqualified from voting based on a felony conviction other than murder or a felony sexual offense may follow to register as a petition circulator.
