Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 21-37 and insert:

(1) Each public school, including charter schools, shall designate a member of the administrative personnel as defined in s. 1012.01(3) to provide annual training regarding human trafficking awareness to instructional personnel as defined in s. 1012.01(2), other administrative personnel, school nurses and school doctors as identified in s. 1012.01(6), and any other personnel deemed by the designated administrative personnel member to have regular contact with students. Such training must also be provided for new employees in such positions within 90 days after they begin their employment. Each employee must

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17 submit to the school-designated member of the administrative
18 personnel a signed and dated acknowledgment of having received
19 the training. The school shall keep such acknowledgment filed
20 electronically.

21 (2) Each school district and charter school shall provide
22 to the designated administrative personnel a comprehensive
23 training curriculum for the annual training described in
24 subsection (1). Such curriculum must be submitted by each school
25 district, along with the curriculum for each charter school in
26 the district, to the Department of Education for approval
