through mail; penalty.-

(1) It is unlawful for any person to sell or distribute prescription hearing aids through the mail to the ultimate consumer. Any person who violates this section commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

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- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a consumer 18 years of age or older may receive prescription hearing aids through the mail if all of the following conditions are met:
- (a) Before the sale, all required testing procedures specified under s. 468.1225 or s. 484.0501 are conducted by an audiologist licensed under s. 468.1185 or a hearing aid specialist licensed under s. 484.045, respectively.
- (b) Upon delivery of the hearing aid, all subsequent testing and fitting procedures are performed in full by the same audiologist or hearing aid specialist who conducted the required testing procedures as specified in paragraph (a).
- (c) The prescription hearing aid provider complies with the consumer protection standards of this part, including ss. 468.1246 and 468.1255, or part II of chapter 484, including ss. 484.0512 and 484.0513, as applicable.
- Section 2. Section 484.054, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 484.054 Sale or distribution of prescription hearing aids through mail; penalty.-
- (1) It is unlawful for any person to sell or distribute prescription hearing aids through the mail to the ultimate consumer. Any violation of this section constitutes a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a consumer 18 years of age or older may receive prescription hearing aids through the mail if all of the following conditions are met:
- (a) Before the sale, all required testing procedures specified under s. 468.1225 or s. 484.0501 are conducted by an
