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Each course within a career and technical education 17 (1)18 curriculum framework for students with disabilities must have at 19 least one associated micro-credential signifying that the 20 student has demonstrated at least five discrete specified career 21 ready practices or career and technical education standards, 22 including an understanding of workplace safety. 23 (a) The department shall work with the Florida Center for 24 Students with Unique Abilities established under s. 1004.6495 25 for the development and implementation of the workforce micro-26 credential program and each micro-credential. 27 (b) The department shall collaborate with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration to develop the specified career 28 29 ready practices or career and technical education standards 30 related to workplace safety. (2) Upon completion of each such course, the student's 31 32 demonstration of the required career ready practices or career 33 and technical education standards must be validated by a member 34 of the instructional staff who specializes in exceptional 35 student education and a member of the student's individualized 36 education plan team prior to the award of the associated micro-37 credential. (3) Beginning with the 2026 calendar year through the 2030 38 calendar year, the department shall prepare an annual report by 39 40 January 31 of the following year detailing the operations of the 41 program.
